We, NHS Humber and North Yorkshire Integrated Care Board,

## Need to understand the views of:

- current and potential future patients, their carers, families and loved ones;
- children and young people who use hospital services or are likely to in the future;
- parents, carers and guardians of children and young people who use hospital services or are likely to in the future;
- health inclusion groups and people with protected characteristics who use hospital services or may use them in the future;
- local authorities;
- ambulance and local transport providers;
- social care providers and VCSE sector organisations;
- neighbouring health and care providers and commissioners;
- hospital staff and other health and social care professionals;
- expert bodies (e.g., Royal Colleges).

**Concerning** proposals to change the way some more complex medical, urgent and emergency care and paediatric (children's) services are delivered at our hospitals in Scunthorpe and Grimsby (Scunthorpe General Hospital and Diana Princess of Wales Hospital, Grimsby).

**So that** the NHS Humber and North Yorkshire Integrated Care Board,

can make a decision about the best way to provide urgent and emergency care; and paediatric hospital services across Northern Lincolnshire.
